The village offers an excellent range of facilities include a selection of independent shops, butcher, post office, three public houses, coffee shops, minisupermarket, medical practice, and a 'Good' OFSTED rated primary school. For further schooling Audlem is within the catchment area of the 'Good' OFSTED rated Brine Leas secondary school and sixth form college in Nantwich. A more comprehensive range of facilities can be found in the market towns of Nantwich, Market Drayton and Whitchurch which are only a short drive away or there is a bus service from the village to all three of these towns.
